## RIV Playtime and Lunchtime arrangements review March 2021

Each Year group will have a dedicated area for playtime, not used by other pupils at the same time they are using it

This will also apply at lunchtime

Reception - outdoor area

Year 1 – KS1 playground and climbing frame and tyres

Year 2 – Far Ks2 playground and spider web climbing frame

Year 3 - Half a of large KS2 playground

Year 4 – Half b of large KS2 playground

Year 5 – Half a of large KS2 playground

Year 6 – Half b of large KS2 playground

KS2 playtimes will be staggered to avoid contact

KS2 lunchtimes 2 classes out at a time on half of KS2 playground each

Pupils will be instructed by staff on the limits of their play area.

Staff from each class will supervise playtime each day.

Pupils will have designated play equipment for their year group only and these will not be used by other groups

Play equipment used will be cleaned at the end of each week.

At playtime, the pupils may struggle to keep socially distant from each other, however staff should still reinforce this and encourage games that help children remain 2m from each other. Staff will have resources and ideas to support playtime activities in a more structured way to support social distancing.

Pupils will observe social distancing at the end of playtime and use the spots provided to guide them.

Pupils should enter school one at a time and wash their hands before entering the classroom.

EYFS will use their outdoor area for child directed outdoor play. There will be no set playtime for EYFS.

## Lunch - Rota system

Reception enter hall to each lunch 11.55 am then outside to play area (outside Nursery)

Year 1 enter hall to eat lunch 12.05 pm then outside to play area (KS1 playground) Year 2 enter hall to eat lunch 12.10 pm then outside to play area (Upper KS2 playground)

Year 3 dinner ladies collect lunch and eat in class 12.00 noon then outside to play area (outside Year 3/4)

Year 4 dinner ladies collect lunch and eat in class 12.10 pm then outside to play area (Outside 5/6)

Year 5 dinner ladies collect lunch and eat in class 12.25 pm then outside to play area (outside 3/4)

Year 6 dinner ladies collect lunch and eat in class 12.30 pm then outside to play area (outside 5/6)

## All Packed lunches for the first 4 days to assist with procedures and timings.

Reduced seating in the hall; with seats on one side of tables only set out for each class/year group

Each class set of tables distanced from other year groups.

Children will wash their hands before consuming food.

Water should be made freely available if required use a plastic cup which will be washed afterwards.

3 separate areas for dirty cutlery and tray collection for R/Yr1 and 2 KS2 bins outside rooms Blue for waste packaging / Red for food .

Pupils will be asked to have a lunch provided by school, where a packed lunch has been brought from home this will be kept under the child's desk and only touched by the child.

All waste will be sealed in a plastic bag, having been placed there by the pupils, when all pupils have finished eating.

A lunchtime supervisor (or other member of staff) will be allocated to each class. Play guidelines (described above) will be observed.

Pupils will move as a group to their outdoor area

While the children are outside, the desks will be cleaned and the rubbish removed by lunchtime supervisors (or other member of staff).

Pupils will be able to order their lunch choice in advance.
